Material must be postmarked no later than March 2, 2020

- All applicants must be a member in good standing of a chartered FFA chapter in Georgia, and the chapter must be registered to attend the 92nd Georgia FFA Convention.
- Convention Talent performers will be announced by April 1.
- Applicants may be selected to perform on the Career Show stage (April 23-24) or on the main Convention stage (April 23-25). Students selected to perform on the main Convention stage must be willing to attend the entire convention and perform at any point during the Convention.
- Of the students selected to perform on the main Arena stage, a handful (4-5) will be selected onsite at the Convention to participate in the second annual Georgia FFA Talent competition. (*More details about the Talent competition will be posted in the coming weeks.*)
